



GEORGE ALLEN – (INDEPENDENT NON-EXECUTIVE)

George began his career in underwriting for Mercantile & General and then with AA Life. He then moved into management and was responsible for new business administration, underwriting and reinsurance with Charter Life while also developing an automated underwriting process for Standard Life.

In 1997 George joined Munich Reinsurance. A global insurance and reinsurance business, with premium income of EUR 48 billion and 43,000 employees. He was responsible for the management of the development teams creating individual life, group life, bank-assurance, health and micro-assurance products. In 2007 George was appointed to run the Group Life portfolio focussing on reinsurance.

George then moved to the Hollard Group in 2010 where he was appointed head of Group Risk International. Hollard is South Africa's largest privately-owned insurance group and provides short-term and life insurance as well as investment products to 6 million policy holders in 10 countries on four continents. Hollard employs almost 3000 people and posted USD 1.2 billion in premium income in the year to June 2014. Hollard is currently on of the PCC's reinsurers.

George has also lectured at the Insurance Institute of Gauteng's Insurance College in subjects such as Life Insurance, Underwriting and Claims. He has a BA Physical Education for Rhodes University (South Africa), a BSc

(Med) (Hons) Biomedical Sciences from the University of Cape Town (South Africa) and a MBA from De Montfort University (England). He is also a Fellow of the Insurance Institute of South Africa, an Associate Underwriter South Africa and is registered with the South African Financial Services Board as a fit and proper candidate having successfully completed the regulatory examinations for Key Individuals (categories 1, 11,11A, 111, and 1V).
