



## IAN CHAMBERS – (NON-EXECUTIVE)

Ian started his career by joining the Law Interpretation Division of the Commissioner for Inland Revenue (now the South African Revenue Service – Sars) for a period of five years until 1990. At Sars he was exposed to all aspects of the Income Tax Act and the workings of the Commissioner's office as well as obtained and retained contacts in Inland Revenue.

Thereafter he was engaged as a consultant at Fisher Hoffman Stride Chartered Accountants ("FHS") and was appointed as a director of FHS Consulting (Pty) Limited and then Managing Director of FHS Personal Financial Planning (Pty) Limited where he participated in all aspects of the South African and international tax law. Ian oversaw the implementation of VAT into retail operations and presented numerous seminars (both income tax and VAT aspects) on behalf of the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants.

In 1998 Ian then was appointed to head up the Structured Finance Division and Project Finance Division of Credit Agricole Indosuez South Africa ("CAISA") reporting directly to the country head and to Paris. He then entered into a retainer contract with CAISA and to team up with Pinet to form Chambers Pinet specialising in tax, assurance and insurance.

In 2001 he created Chambers Consulting to specialise in tax consulting before joining Routledge Madise Attorneys (Eversheds) as a director in 2003 and started their taxation and exchange control departments.

Ian then emigrated from South Africa to Mauritius in 2008 and continued consulting through Ian Chambers Consulting Limited - advising a large client base of high net worth individuals on tax and providing accounting, foreign exchange and related financial planning services.

He is also a Fellow of the Institute of Life and Pension Advisers and is a Certified Financial Planner. Ian is the previous chairman of the Audit Committee of Sable Holdings Limited, a company previously listed on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange and consults to the South African to numerous management companies based in Mauritius in respect of taxation and exchange control issues. Ian also serves on the boards of Tadvest Limited and Regis Holdings Limited, both companies which are listed on the Stock Exchange Mauritius.
